

## **Fostering the Arts Scholarship Application**

We are grateful that generous members of our community have joined with Fostering the Arts, Inc to create a scholarship program to support families with financial need. These funds will also be available to the foster children that participate in our program. We recognize that program fees may constitute a significant burden for some students and their families and those additional scholarship opportunities may help to offset some or all of the costs of these extracurricular activities. The Fostering the Arts Scholarship Fund, which will be managed by a board of directors, will provide financial support to students with a demonstrated financial need or who are experiencing hardship.

Students that meet ONE of the eligibility criteria may request a financial scholarship for the 2017-2018 season. Criteria are listed below. These criteria are as follows:

Meet the qualifications for "poverty" as defined by the US Department of Health & Human Services.

Persons in Family/Household	Poverty Guideline

For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$4,160 for each additional person.

• Demonstrate financial need through the submission of tax return and current month's pay and/or bank statements.

Financial scholarships will be awarded based on student need, availability of scholarship funds, and the number of students qualifying for the scholarship. Scholarships will be awarded based on AVAILABLE funds, which will vary and may be limited based on donations. **Priority will be given to students with the greatest financial need**. Scholarships will range from 10% to 100% of the participation fee.

## Applications must include:

- 1. Completed Fostering the Arts Scholarship Application
- 2. Verification of Household Income:
  - A. Copy of last year's tax return(s)
  - B. Current month's pay stub(s)
  - C. Copies of bank statements
- 3. One page student essay describing one of the following:
- For new students, why he/she wants to participate in arts based programs
- For returning students, what value they have received from extracurricular activities in the arts

(If student is not old enough to write their own essay, parent may write it for them.)

Scholarship deadlines for seasons/activities will be posted on our website, Facebook page, and will be communicated via email.
